WHY ARE WE HERE



At the beginning of 2019 four research and innovation cybersecurity projects – CyberSec4Europe, SPARTA, CONCORDIA and ECHO – were funded for four years to pilot the proposed regulation to create for a new European Cybersecurity Industrial, Technology and Research Competence Centre and a network of national coordination centres.

The funding for those projects (sadly) finished over the course of the last year and the Competence Centre is getting established in Bucharest as are the national coordination centres across Europe.

WHAT IS CONVERGENCE?



CONVERGENCE was the name given to several concertation events that pro-actively brought together representatives from the European institutions and agencies, cybersecurity communities, ecosystem innovators, the other three pilot projects and other cybersecurity projects in order to achieve a fully sustainable competence network and comprehensive integrated European cybersecurity ecosystem for the benefit of European industry, the European research community and ultimately benefitting the European citizen.
