**Antonio Ramos** has a degree in Economic and Business from the University Complutense of Madrid and a Master in Financial Audit from the University Pontificia of Salamanca, Certified Information Systems Auditor (CISA), Certified Information Security Manager (CISM) y Certified in Risk and Information System Control (CRISC) by ISACA, Certificate of Cloud Security Knowledge (CCSK) by CSA - Cloud Security Alliance, Certified Data Privacy Professional (CDPP) by DPI – Data Privacy Institute, ITIL Service Manager, COBIT 5 Foundation / Implementation / Assessor / Trainer by APMG Internacional.

Currently Antonio is Managing Partner at n+1 Intelligence and Research and CEO at leet security, in addition to VicePresident of ISACA Madrid Chapter, where he acted as Treasurer between 2004 and 2006 and as President between 2010 and 2014, member of Government and Regulatory Advocacy Subcommittee 3 of ISACA, and member of ENISA Expert List. Antonio began his career as Systems Auditor in 1998 for EY, where he achieved the position of Manager in charge of Information Security Management area inside Technology and Security Risks Services business (TSRS). In 2004, Antonio joined S21sec, a company focused on information security as System Audit and Consultancy VP, holding different responsibilities positions as responsible for Unified Managed Security Services (UMSS) and collaborating in the launching of its CERT and in the definition of the strategy for critical infrastructures protection and the building of incident response team.

Antonio has specialized in information security management according to international standards (COBIT, ITIL, ISO 27001...), and strategic consultancy and security governance. Additionally, he is accredited as auditor for ASIMELEC Certificates Service Provider Certification and has been homologated as QSA by the PCI Security Standards Council between 2005 and 2010. He is member of Subcommittee 27 and Subcommittee 38 of AENOR, of ISMS Forum Spain Board Committee and he es founder member of Cloud Security Alliance Spanish Chapter, CSA-ES. And, finally, he contributed to GIPIC I, informal group created by CNPIC to develop minimal contents and best practice guidance to develop operator security plan and specific protection plans.

Finally, Antonio is associated teacher of Instituto de Empresa regarding security governance and teaches in a number of courses, both for information systems auditors and CISOs, some of them as support for CISA and CISM exams and also in de seguridad, algunos de ellos como apoyo a la obtención del CISA y del CISM, Risk Analyst and Information Security Corporate Governance courses organized by ISMS Forum Spain, and of Expert courses in cloud computing and in critical infrastructure security of University of Universidad of Alcalá de Henares.
