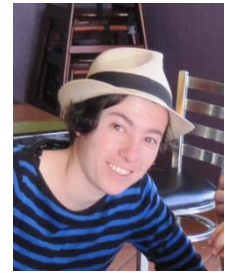


Carmela Troncoso
