Tanya Ignatenko was born in Minsk, Belarus. She received her MSc. degree (with Honors) in applied mathematics from Belarussian State University, Minsk, Belarus, in 2001. In 2004 she obtained her PDEng degree from Stan Akkermans Institute (Mathematics for Industry Program) and in 2009 her Ph.D degree in Electrical Engineering from Eindhoven University of Technology.

From 2008 till 2010 Tanya was a PostDoc researcher in both the Signal Processing Systems Group (80%) of Electrical Engineering Department and Coding and Crypto Group (20%) of Mathematics and Computer Science Department at the TU/e.
