What is a wallet?

• It's an app

- Probably a mobile app
- Could be web-based

To manage data

- Assets (information, verified attributes, accounts)
- Transactions (data sharing, disclosure of information, payments)

Controlled by a user

- Verified identity
- Identifier (account?)

(Data may or may not be bound to that user/wallet/device)





European Digital Identity Wallet



EU Wallet

The Member States are **required** to issue a wallet and identity to all citizens

- All (E)EU residents will have (free) access to a mobile national eID
- With government-grade assurance (identity & wallet-app)
- Usable with public and private service providers
- Across borders
- Extensible with verified attributes from different (qualified) sources
- Enabling use for qualified signatures

This is part of the eIDAS2 regulation

- Regulation will come into force early next year
- Specifications & implementing acts are work in progress
- Target launch by MS 2026/2027 (first deployments in 2025)








Wallets need an ecosystem

Collaboration between different actors




The ecosystem is more important than the wallet(s)





Getting the ecosystem going

- eIDAS2 coming into force in 2023 (European legislation)
 - Issuing of wallets and identities will be mandatory for Member States
 - Implementing acts defining all the interfaces, roles and responsibilities (legislation!)
- Specifications and Architecture Reference Framework
 - Specifications are being written by the Toolbox
 - By eIDAS expert group representatives from all Member States
 - Producing epics and Architecture reference framework (ARF) monthly releases
- Reference Implementation Wallet
 - Open source wallet for Member States ("just add flag")
 - Provided by NiScy, based on the epics from the Toolbox
- Funding
 - Large Scale Pilots demonstrating ecosystems
 - Other reusable building blocks







The future is decentralised





The future is decentralised – SSI promises:

- Better security
 - Anti-tracking I prevent anyone knowing what I share with whom
- Better privacy
 - Privacy-by-design I can prove something without revealing other information
 - User in control
 - No central authority or (vulnerable) data store I decide about sharing and manage my own data
 - Usability
