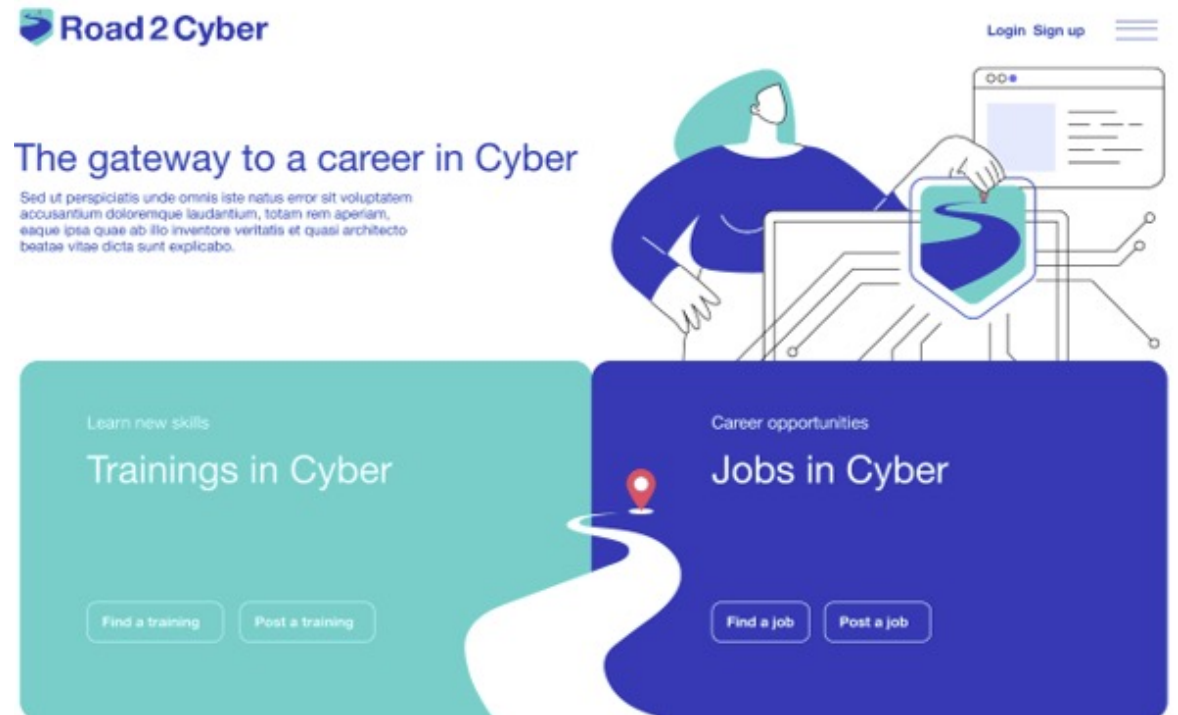

- 2) To stimulate an interest for a career in cybersecurity among the European youth

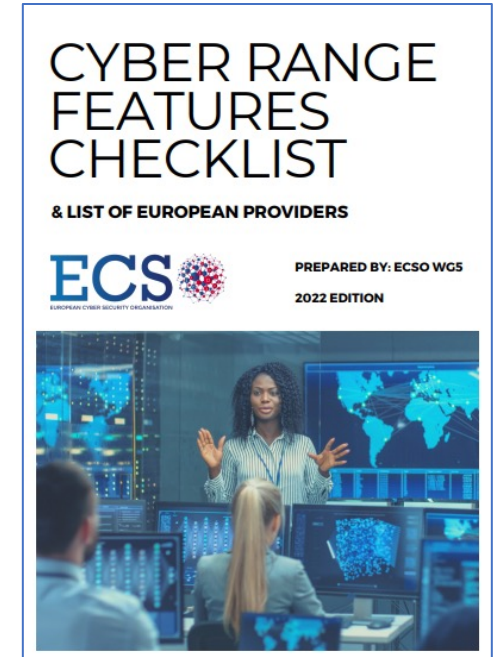
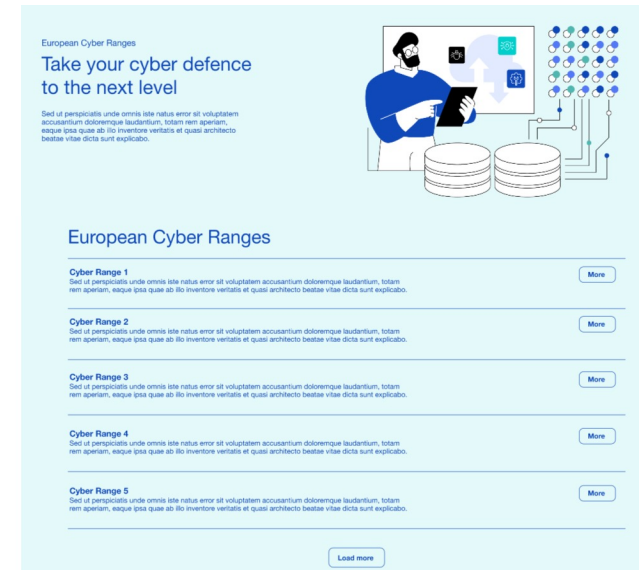




Other paths to improve skills in cyber

- Access ECSO's Cyber Ranges Checklist and use it to define your needs (end users) or tailor your offer (providers)



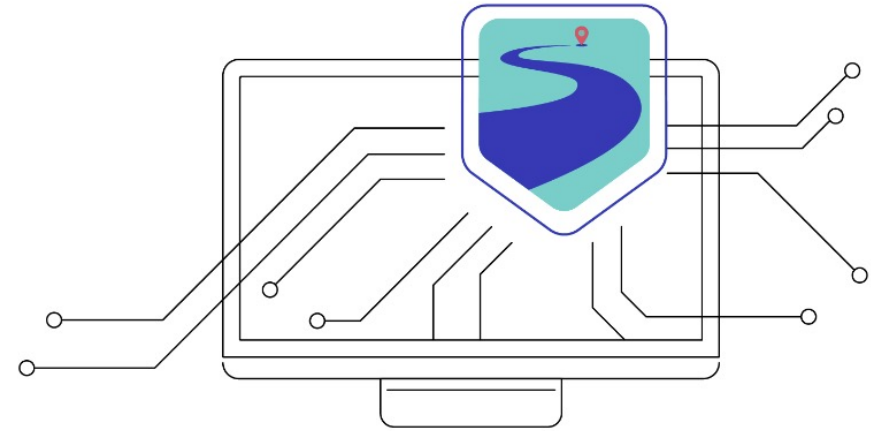

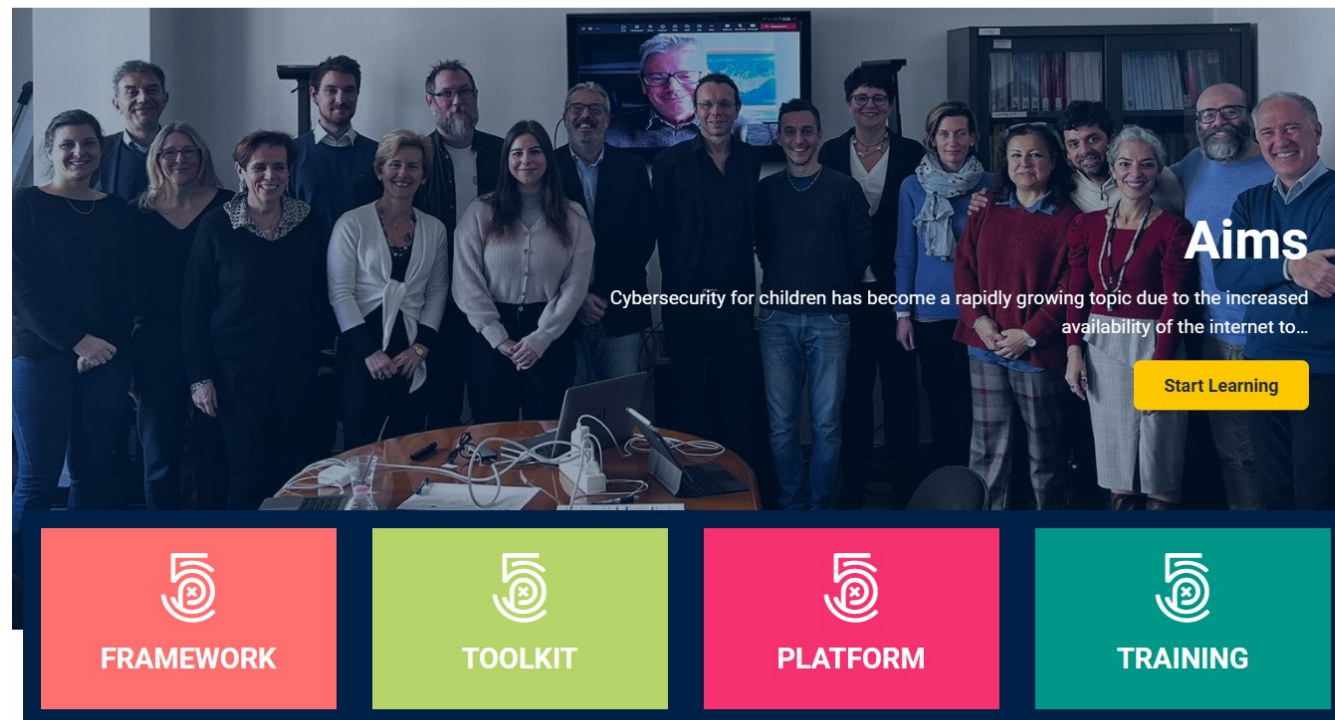
