



Road2Cyber: the spirit of lifelong learning

<u>Goals</u>

- 1. Empower job seekers with skills, knowledge, and access to jobs (also via training and mentorship);
- 2. Facilitate the recruitment process by bridging the gap between universities/graduates and employers;
- 3. Promote and strengthen gender balance in cybersecurity;
- 4. Promote training providers, cyber ranges and other services from ECSO members and Women4Cyber partners.







<u>Goal</u>

Educate and raise the awareness of young people (6 to 26-year olds) on cybersecurity

Two core objectives

- 1) To raise the level of cyber hygiene
- To stimulate an interest for a career in cybersecurity among the European youth


